DISCUSSION TOPICS

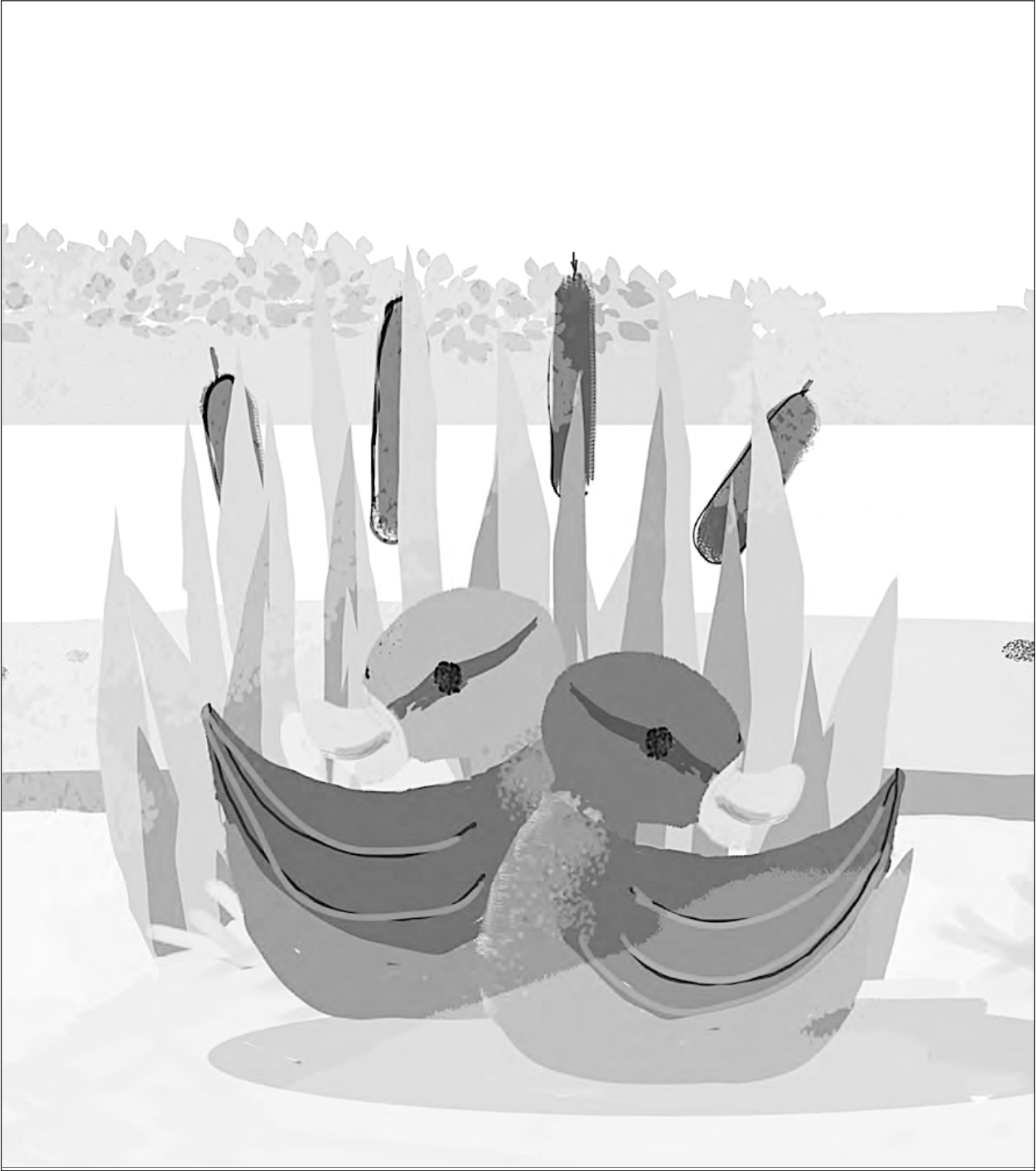
Before, during, and after reading the book
