The Academics, Explorers, Campers and Adventurers are all standing in separate groups around the edges of the stage/performing space.

All (excitedly) Have you ever had an extraordinary wish?

Explorers To soar like an eagle?

Academics To shimmer with fish?

Campers Perhaps you dream of skipping through stars?

Adventurers Of harnessing unicorns, sailing round Mars?

All The extraordinary bellows!

Explorers It trumpets!

Adventurers And booms!

Academics It towers above us,

Campers It blazes and blooms.

Academics run into the centre of the stage. Perhaps they have notebooks and are pacing, scribbling down notes, scratching their heads ...

Academic 1 & 2 But what of the extraordinary, everyday thing?

Academic 3 & 4 The soft, quiet moment that makes the world sing?

The **Explorers** suddenly spot a small lion cub in the centre of the stage (can be a toy or imagined). They slowly begin to creep forward - not wanting to disturb or alarm. The **Academics** take notice.

Academic 5 (beckoning to audience and pointing at the **Explorers**) This is

the time you must listen and look ...

The **Academics** move backwards to make space for the **Explorers** as they walk into the centre of the stage.

Academics ... for it's found in the branches, the puddle, the nook.

The Academics move back to their original position. The Explorers move to centre stage. One of the Explorers picks up the lion cub. They all sit around and take turns stroking it.

Explorers You'll find it is fleeting – a whisper, a wink.

Explorer 1 & 2 It tiptoes in quietly, is gone in a blink.

Explorer 3 & 4 It bursts on your tongue and it sings in the spring.

Explorer 5 It flickers like sunshine and lifts up a wing.

Explorer 5 beckons all the **Explorers** to get in position, so they can take a photo.

Explorer 5 Sometimes it's a glimpse, a picture you take.

Explorers The moments you treasure. The magic you make.

The Explorers walk back into their original position on the edge of the stage. The Campers walk into the centre. They are positioned in a camping scene. Perhaps Camper 1 and 2 are reclining, looking at the stars. Camper 3, 4 and 5 could be warming their hands by a fire.

Campers It's a night in a tent in a faraway land, curled up together, hand

upon hand.

Camper 1 & 2 It's soaring with birds to the top of the trees

Camper 3 & 4 It's feeling the kiss of a cheeky cool breeze

Camper 5 It's staying out late for a spine-tingling show

Campers The wonder and awe of a golden moon's glow.

The Adventurers tiptoe towards centre stage as the Campers leave.

Adventurers 1 Is it tiptoeing bravely past giants asleep?

Adventurer 2 & 3 Or breathing the stillness of forests that creep?

Adventurer 4 & 5 Or digging for artifacts lost long ago

Adventurers Discovering the riches buried below?

The Campers, Explorers and Academics all gather around the Adventurers in the centre of the stage.

All These are the moments that twinkle and shine

Academics They're tiny and swift,

Explorers But they're yours and they're mine

Campers You can reach for the grand and the mighty it's true.

Adventurers Just remember the ordinary...

All ... is extraordinary too.
