EDUCATIONAL APPLICABILITY

Oh, Sir Bragalot! is a laugh-out-loud book about a cheeky knight who loves to brag and boast about what an amazingly brave knight he is. Braggers can often create tricky or embarrassing situations for themselves and this happens to Sir Bragalot when he's asked by the Queen to go on a dangerous quest! In a humorous way, this story touches upon the dangers of bragging.

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DISCUSSION TOPICS

Before, during and after reading the book

- 1. Introduce Oh, Sir Bragalot! to the children and ask them what they think the story might be about.
- 2. Talk about what 'to brag' and 'to boast' mean. Is boasting a good character trait? What's the opposite of to boast?
- 3. Why do you think Sir Bragalot brags?
- 4. How do you think Sir Bragalot feels when the Queen suggests that he fights the dragon right outside the kingdom?
- 5. Sir Bragalot goes on a bit of an emotional roller coaster when he meets the dragon. He's petrified one minute, but then is back to his usual boasting the next when he sees how tiny the dragon is. Have you ever felt different emotions one after the other?
- 6. Do you think that Sir Bragalot will ever change his ways?
- 7. After reading the book, ask them what they thought of the story. Which was their favourite part and why?
- 8. Ask the children what was the funniest part of the story? On which page did they laugh the loudest?

Imagine what else Sir Bragalot might boast and brag about. Then, draw and colour in all your brilliant ideas (but don't brag about them!)




A-MAZE-ING QUEST
